

RESOLUTION 93- 61

RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE FOR ADMINISTRATIVE PURPOSES OF UP TO TEN PERCENT (10%) OF THE COUNTY'S LOCAL HOUSING DISTRIBUTION RECEIVED PURSUANT TO THE STATE HOUSING INITIATIVE PARTNERSHIP ACT.

**WHEREAS**, the State of Florida has established the State Housing Initiative Partnership (SHIP) Program for the purpose of providing funds to local governments as an incentive for the creation of partnerships to produce and preserve affordable housing; and

**WHEREAS**, St. Johns County has been notified by the State of its eligibility to receive the SHIP Program funds in the amount of \$250,000 Grant-in-Aid and the County's allocation of \$250,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the County has studied its current staff and funding sources and consequently determined that five percent (5%) of the County's local housing distribution received from the State of Florida pursuant to the SHIP act will be insufficient to pay the necessary costs of administering the County's local housing assistance program; and

**WHEREAS**, the County by local resolution may use up to 10% of such local housing distribution funds for administrative purposes in support of the County's local housing assistance program including salaries, equipment, supplies, audits, rent, utilities and related expenses; and

**WHEREAS**, the implementation of this program will enhance the affordable housing stock within St. Johns County.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida authorizes the expenditure of up to ten percent (10%) of the County's local housing distribution received from the State of Florida pursuant to the SHIP Act for administrative expenses to support the County's local housing assistance program.

This resolution shall become effective on the later of (i) the date of its adoption or (ii) the date that St. Johns County Ordinance 93-21 becomes effective.
