RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPROVING A CERTAIN LICENSE AGREEMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT TO GIVE ST. AUGUSTINE SAILING, INC. PERMISSION TO MOVE A BREAKWATER WITHIN THE COUNTY RIGHT-OF-WAY AND RIPARIAN AREA OF SURFSIDE AVENUE.

WHEREAS, St. Augustine Sailing, Inc. has requested permission from St. Johns County to move the existing 386' breakwater to the north; and

WHEREAS, this would place the breakwater 290' west of the paved west end of Surfside Avenue and in line with the right-of-way and riparian area of the County as more fully shown and described in the License Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A, incorporated by reference and made a part hereof.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

Section 1. That the above described License Agreement is hereby approved by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida and the County Administrator is authorized to execute the Agreement.

Section 2. The Clerk is instructed to record the License Agreement in the official records of St. Johns County, Florida, and mail copies to Douglas D. Crane, c/o St. Augustine Sailing, Inc., Camachee Island, St. Augustine, FL 32084.

LICENSE AGREEMENT

This agreement, entered into this 26 day of July , 1994, between ST. JOHNS COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, by and through its Board of County Commissioners, hereinafter called "County", and St. Augustine Sailing, Inc., hereinafter called "SAS".

WHEREAS, SAS, has requested permission from St. Johns County to move the existing 386' breakwater to the north; and

WHEREAS, this would place the breakwater 290' west of the paved west end of Surfside Avenue and in line with the County right-of-way as more fully shown on Exhibit A, attached hereto, incorporated by reference and made a part hereof.

NOW WITNESSETH, that the County, for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter mentioned to be kept and performed by SAS does permit SAS, the right to use the extended right-of-way of Surfside Boulevard in St. Johns County, Florida.

- To maintain a license for the use of the above described premises for a term of 15 years, extended for additional
 15 year periods upon the mutual consent of both parties.
- 2. The property is to be used for the relocation site of 290' breakwater. Any maintenance and improvements will be made by SAS, which shall construct said breakwater in sound condition and maintain it in good repair during the period of this Agreement.
- This License shall be nonexclusive and SAS will allow the continuance of any use or access by the general public which have become customary on the premises.

 Moreover, SAS agrees to allow the County to grant any other easements deemed necessary during the period of this Agreement.
- 4. SAS agrees not to hold the County liable or responsible for any and all zoning, building, use, or other governmental restrictions which may frustrate the intention of this Agreement. SAS assumes all liability for compliance of all government regulations applicable for construction and maintenance of the breakwater.
- 5. All improvements placed on the premises shall become the property of the County upon the termination of this Agreement or any renewal thereof. However, the County may at its option, require SAS to remove, at SAS's

expense any or all of said improvements and to restore the property to its original condition upon termination or expiration of this Agreement, or any renewals thereof.

- 6. Any sale of the majority of the stock, now held by SAS, to other persons shall be construed to be an assignment of this Agreement, and SAS shall obtain written consent of the County prior to any such assignment.
- 7. It is hereby determined by the County that exclusive use of the above described property will not be necessary for County purpose during the term of this Agreement.
- 8. The use of the area within the right-of-way shall be at the sole risk of St. Augustine Sailing, Inc., who shall hold the County harmless for any injuries, law or damage to person or property occurring on the premises indirectly or directly covered by the construction or existence of the breakwater. The County shall not be responsible for maintaining loss or casualty insurance of any kind in relation to said breakwater.
- This instrument may be amended or modified only by an instrument of equal formality signed by the respective parties.

IN WITNESS THEREOF, the County and St. Augustine Sailing, Inc. have caused this instrument to be executed for the purpose herein expressed the day and year first below written.


