RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY SUPPORTING THE PALLONE-McMILLAN-LAMBERT AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4683 WHICH AUTHORIZES STATES AND QUALIFIED POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS TO EXERCISE CONTROL OVER MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida that the Board supports and recommends the adoption of the Pallone-McMillan-Lambert Amendment to H.R. 4684 which authorizes states and qualified political subdivisions to exercise control over municipal solid waste.
