

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA ESTABLISHING THE RATE OF THE ANNUAL SOLID WASTE NON AD VALOREM COLLECTION ASSESSMENT AND THE RATE OF THE ANNUAL SOLID WASTE NON AD VALOREM RECYCLE ASSESSMENT LEVIED PURSUANT TO ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE 94-7, AS AMENDED, AND ADOPTING THE ANNUAL NON AD VALOREM COLLECTION ASSESSMENT ROLL AND THE ANNUAL NON AD VALOREM RECYCLE ASSESSMENT ROLL PERTAINING THERETO.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida as follows:

Section 1. The rate or amount of the Collection Assessment levied pursuant to St. Johns County ordinance 94-7, as amended, shall be \$ 89.00 for the year 1994 and for each year thereafter until modified by subsequent County resolution or ordinance. Such rate or amount shall be charged, assessed and levied each year on and for each residence, dwelling unit, and habitat, whether occupied or not, (the "unit of measurement") located upon Non Exempt Residential Property on January 1 of the year in which levied; all in the manner provided by St. Johns County ordinance 94-7, as amended, and Florida Statute 197.3632.

Section 2. The rate or amount of the Recycle Assessment levied pursuant to St. Johns County ordinance 94-7, as amended, shall be \$ 28.00 for the year 1994 and for each year thereafter until modified by subsequent County resolution or ordinance. Such rate or amount shall be charged, assessed and levied each year on and for each residence, dwelling unit, and

habitat, whether occupied or not, (the "unit of measurement") located upon Non Exempt Residential Property on January 1 of the year in which levied; all in the manner provided by St. Johns County ordinance 94-7, as amended, and Florida Statutes 197.3632.

Section 3. The non ad valorem collection assessment roll attached hereto is hereby adopted as the St. Johns County solid waste non ad valorem collection assessment roll. The amount of the rates shown therein shall be controlled by Board resolutions. The solid waste non ad valorem collection assessment shall be collected each year until and unless determined otherwise by subsequent resolution or ordinance of the County.

Section 4. The non ad valorem recycle assessment roll attached hereto is hereby adopted as the St. Johns County solid waste non ad valorem recycle assessment roll. The amount of the rates shown thereon shall be controlled by Board resolutions. The solid waste non ad valorem recycle assessment shall be collected each year until and unless determined otherwise by subsequent resolution or ordinance of the County.

Section 5. By September 15, 1994 and by September 15 each year thereafter, the County Administrator shall certify the solid waste non ad valorem collection assessment roll, with such additions and deletions each year as are appropriate, on compatible electronic medium to the St. Johns County tax collector with the dollar amount of the solid waste non ad

valorem collection assessment due that year for each parcel posted thereon.

Section 6. By September 15, 1994 and by September 15 each year thereafter, the County Administrator shall certify the solid waste non ad valorem recycle assessment roll, with such additions and deletions each year as are appropriate, on compatible electronic medium to the St. Johns County tax collector with the dollar amount of the solid waste non ad valorem recycle assessment due that year for each parcel posted thereon.

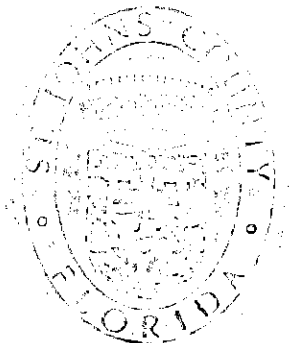

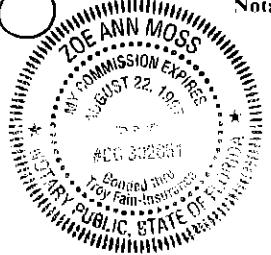

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA TO ESTABLISH THE ANNUAL SOLID WASTE NON AD VALOREM ASSESSMENT COLLECTION RATE AT \$95.00 PER YEAR; TO ESTABLISH THE ANNUAL SOLID WASTE NON AD VALOREM ASSESSMENT RECYCLE RATE AT \$30.00 PER YEAR; TO ADOPT A SOLID WASTE NON AD VALOREM COLLECTION ASSESSMENT ROLL; AND TO ADOPT A SOLID WASTE NON AD VALOREM RECYCLE ASSESSMENT ROLL.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Tuesday, the 23 day of August, 1994, at 5:00 o'clock p.m. the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida will hold a public hearing in the County Auditorium of the County Administration Building of 4020 Lewis Speedway, St. Augustine, Florida to establish the rate of the annual solid waste non ad valorem collection assessment of \$95.00 per year and the rate of the annual solid waste non ad valorem recycle assessment of \$30.00 per year. Each such rate shall continue in effect until modified by future county ordinances or resolutions. The collection assessment and the recycle assessment are levied pursuant to St. Johns County Ordinance 94-7, as amended.

A further purpose of the hearing is to adopt a non ad valorem assessment roll for the collection assessment and a non ad valorem assessment roll for the recycle assessment. The purpose of the collection assessment is to fund the cost to the County, including debt service, of providing, maintaining and/or operating Residential Solid Waste collection services and/or facilities that are available for use by Non Exempt Residential Property and to pay the costs of collecting such assessments. The purpose of the recycle assessment is to fund the cost to the County, including debt service, of providing, maintaining and/or operating Residential Solid Waste Recycling Services and/or facilities that are available for use by Non Exempt Residential Property and to pay the cost of collecting such assessments. (The capitalized terms have the same meanings as in St. Johns County Ordinance 94-7, as amended.) The collection assessment and the recycle assessment do not include the funding of solid waste landfill disposal costs.

All Non Exempt Residential Property located within the unincorporated area of St. Johns County as such area is depicted in the map in this notice is subject to the annual solid waste non ad valorem collection assessment and the annual solid waste non ad valorem recycle assessment. The term "Non Exempt Residential Property" is defined in St. Johns County Ordinance 94-7, as amended.

The \$95.00 solid waste non ad valorem collection assessment and the \$30.00 solid waste non ad valorem recycle assessment will be applied each year against each residence, dwelling unit, and habit, whether occupied or not, located upon Non Exempt Residential Property on the preceding January 1. The collection assessment and the recycle assessment will be collected each year commencing November 1994 in the manner and at the times that ad valorem taxes are collected and shall be subject to all collection provisions pertaining to ad valorem taxes.

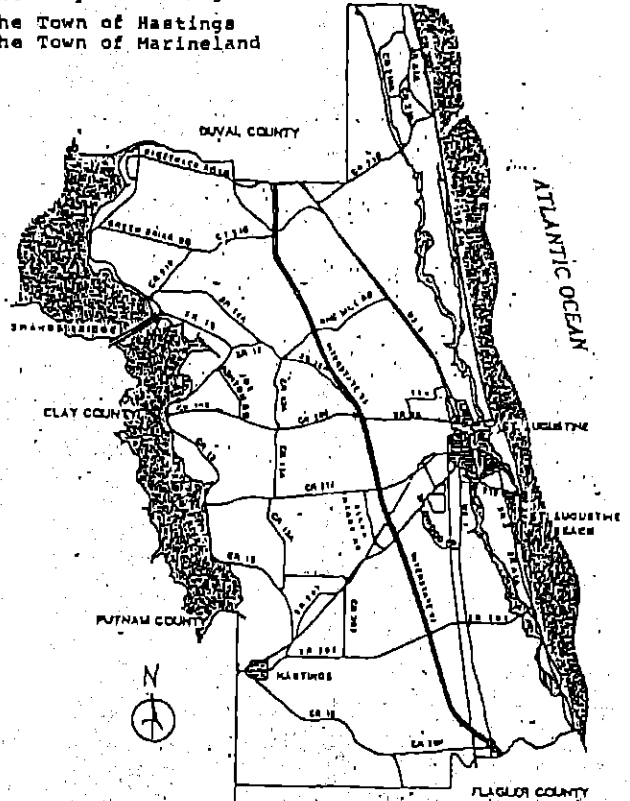
The collection assessment and the recycle assessment will be collected by the tax collector. All affected property owners have a right to appear at the hearing and the right to file written objections with the St. Johns County Board of County Commissioners located at 4020 Lewis Speedway, St. Augustine, FL 32085 within 20 days of this notice.

IF A PERSON DECIDES TO APPEAL MADE BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS WITH RESPECT TO ANY MATTER CONSIDERED AT SUCH HEARING, SUCH PERSON WILL NEED A RECORD OF THE PROCEEDINGS, AND, FOR SUCH PURPOSE, SUCH PERSON MAY NEED TO ENSURE THAT A VERBATIM RECORD OF THE PROCEEDINGS IS MADE, WHICH RECORD INCLUDES THE TESTIMONY AND EVIDENCE UPON WHICH THE APPEAL IS TO BE BASED.
