RESOLUTION NO. 94-217

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR CERTAIN SERVICES RENDERED BY THE COUNTY IN CONNECTION WITH THE COUNTY UTILITIES, AND PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENT AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, is authorized by Ordinance No. 93-14, Section 14, Paragraph E, to establish by Resolution and collect fees and charges for certain services.

WHEREAS, the attached schedule of fees and charges represent rates that are based on averaging strength and operating cost related to treatment and disposal of Leachate.

WHEREAS, calculation of rates may be reviewed each year and adjustments recommended as needed.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida:

Section 1 - Leachate Definition:

"Leachate" means a liquid waste as a result of chemical and biochemical reactions of the landfilled waste and the percolation of liquids through solid waste while it simultaneously extracts dissolved or suspended materials. The sources of the liquid include moisture contained in the landfilled solid waste, rainfall, and surface groundwater infiltration.

<u>Section 2</u> - Approval of Fees and Charges:

The schedule of fees and charges which is attached hereto and made part hereof as Exhibit "A" and is hereby adopted.

Section 3 - Collection of Fees:

The fees and charges shall be paid to and collected by the Utility Department for deposit in the Utility Enterprise Fund.

Section 4 - Effective Date:

This Resolution shall take effect on the date of its passage.
