RESOLUTION NO. 94-50

RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A CONSENT ORDER AGREEMENT WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AND TO EXPEND APPROXIMATELY \$350,000 TO REPAIR THE LEACHATE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM, SECTOR I, PHASE II, TILLMAN RIDGE LANDFILL TO BRING THE SYSTEM INTO COMPLIANCE WITH FDEP PERMIT NO. SC55-155423.

WHEREAS, the St. Johns County Solid Waste Department and the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) have been discussing the remedial actions required to bring the Leachate Management System located in Sector I, Phase II, Tillman Ridge Landfill into compliance with permit conditions (FDEP Permit No. SC55-155423); and,

WHEREAS, as a result of these discussions a Consent Order (OGC No. 93-4641) is being issued by the FDEP. This Consent Order requires that the Leachate Management System be retrofitted as per plans submitted to the FDEP by HDR Engineering, Inc. on February 18, 1994 and construction completed within a set period of time; and

WHEREAS, the total anticipated cost of the project is \$350,000.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida that the County Administrator is authorized to enter into a Consent Order Agreement with the Florida Department of Environmental Protection and to expend \$350,000 to retrofit the Leachate Management System located in Sector I, Phase II, Tillman Ridge Landfill.
