

RESOLUTION NO. 94- 61

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING A BILL INTRODUCED IN THE UNITED STATES HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES (HR3641) BY THE HONORABLE TILLIE K. FOWLER, U.S. REPRESENTATIVE, 4TH DISTRICT, STATE OF FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, the Coastal Barriers Resource Act of 1990 has adversely impacted certain property owners in St. Johns County; and

WHEREAS, research by the Administrative, Engineering and Planning Departments of the County and the Property Appraiser's Office indicates that some data used by agencies of the Federal Government to create "no Federal Flood insurance" zones in St. Johns County was incomplete or misinterpreted; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, and United States Representative Tillie K. Fowler seek relief for landowners in the County who have mistakenly been included in "no insurance" zones; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned Departments of St. Johns County, Florida, have channeled specific and accurate information to U.S. Representative Tillie K. Fowler for the relief of certain County landowners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that it unanimously supports HR3641, a bill introduced in the U.S. House of Representatives by Rep. Tillie K. Fowler to amend the Coastal Barrier Resource Act of 1990 so that certain properties within the County mistakenly placed in "no insurance" zones shall be removed from such zones and be granted coverage by the National Flood Insurance Program so that the landowners may enjoy the full use and value of their property.
