RESOLUTION NO. 94-63

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, DESIGNATING A PORTION OF NINE MILE ROAD AS A "ST. JOHNS COUNTY SCENIC ROADWAY".

WHEREAS, St. Johns County, Florida, encompasses a wide variety of scenic land and water vistas; and

WHEREAS, portions of some St. Johns County roads pass through or by such scenic vistas; and

WHEREAS, the St. Johns County Board of County Commissioners deems it an appropriate duty and rightful pleasure to draw public attention to certain roads passing through or by specific County vistas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that the specific portion of Nine Mile Road which passes through Twelve Mile Swamp shall henceforth be designated a "St. Johns County Scenic Roadway" and be marked with appropriate signage to that effect.
