

RESOLUTION 94-75

RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF THE COUNTY'S STATE HOUSING INITIATIVES PARTNERSHIP (SHIP) HOUSING ASSISTANCE PLAN FOR FY 94-95 AND THE AMENDMENTS FOR THE HOUSING ASSISTANCE PLAN FOR FY 92-93 AND FY 93-94 TO THE FLORIDA HOUSING FINANCE AGENCY FOR CONTINUANCE OF SHIP MONIES.

WHEREAS, the State of Florida has established the State Housing Initiatives Partnership (SHIP) Program for the purpose of providing funds to local governments as an incentive for the creation of partnerships to procure and preserve affordable housing; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County has been notified by the State of its eligibility to receive the SHIP Program funds in the amount of \$250,000 as a Grant-in-Aid and the County's allocation of \$250,000; and

WHEREAS, the implementation of the SHIP Program will enhance the affordable housing stock within St. Johns County; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County must submit a Housing Assistance Plan subject to approval of the Florida Housing Finance Agency to receive SHIP monies; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County has had a two-year Housing Assistance Plan for FY 92-93 and FY 93-94 approved by the Florida Housing Finance Agency on July 30, 1993; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County seeks to submit a third year Housing Assistance Plan similar to the approved two-year Plan and simultaneously request minor amendments to the two-year Plan.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, authorizes that the FY 94-95 Housing Assistance Plan and the amended Housing Assistance Plan for FY 92-93 and FY 93-94 approved by the St. Johns County Affordable Housing Advisory Committee on April 13, 1994, be submitted to the Florida Housing Finance Agency for continued funding of the SHIP Program.
