is hereby vacated and all streets situated therein, none of which have become highways necessary for use by the traveling public, and the Stormwater Drainage Tracts and all other easements are hereby vacated and abandoned, and this Board hereby renounces and disclaims any right of St. Johns County and the public, which is solely established by virtue of the recorded Plat of Julington Creek Unit Six, in and to the above described Property, easements, Stormwater Drainage Tracts and streets situated therein; such Property, easements, Stormwater Drainage

Tracts and streets being returned into acreage. However, the "Land Owners" individually retain and shall acquire all ownership, interests, and rights to that real property underlying the vacated portion of said plat to which they hold title to prior to the vacation or acquire by virtue of being adjoining property owners.

- 3. That a certified copy of this resolution shall be filed in the offices of the Clerk of the Circuit Court and duly recorded in the public records of St. Johns County, Florida.
 - 4. That the applicant shall pay all recording costs.


