**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA,
VACATING A PORTION OF THE PLAT OF
JULINGTON CREEK UNIT SEVEN**

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed by the qualified fee simple land owners (St. Johns County, Atlantic Gulf Communities Corporation and the School Board of St. Johns County, Florida) to vacate a portion of a certain subdivision plat hereinafter described in accordance with Section 177.101 Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, Notice of the intent to request the vacation has been duly published and Proof of Publication has been filed with this Board; and

WHEREAS, all county taxes required to be paid, have been paid, and vacation of a portion of the plat will not deny convenient public access; and

WHEREAS, it appears that there are no objections and the facts contained in the petition

are true; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of the dedication on the plat, the dedicator reserved to itself, its successors and assigns a reversionary interest in Tracts "G-1" through "G-43", inclusive, and Tracts "W-1" and "W-2" (Stormwater Drainage Tracts); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of St. Johns County has determined that it does not require the dedication of the Stormwater Drainage Tracts for any County purpose and has determined that any stormwater drainage within the portion of the subdivision plat hereinafter described shall be the responsibility of the land owner, its successors and assigns;

NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PREMISES, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the allegations of fact recited in Paragraphs 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 of the Petition are hereby adopted as findings of fact in this Resolution.

2. That the following described portion of the plat of Julington Creek Unit Seven, recorded in Map Book 18, pages 6 through 32, inclusive, of the public records of St. Johns County, Florida, to wit:

SEE EXHIBIT "A", ATTACHED HERETO AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

is hereby vacated and all streets situated therein, none of which have become highways necessary for use by the traveling public, and the Stormwater Drainage Tracts and all other easements are hereby vacated and abandoned, and this Board hereby renounces and disclaims any right of St. Johns County and the public, which is solely established by virtue of the recorded Plat of Julington Creek Unit Seven, in and to the above described Property, easements, Stormwater Drainage Tracts and streets situated therein; such Property, easements, Stormwater Drainage

Tracts and streets being returned into acreage. However, the "Land Owners" individually retain and shall acquire all ownership, interests, and rights to that real property underlying the vacated portion of said plat to which they hold title to prior to the vacation or acquire by virtue of being adjoining property owners.

3. That a certified copy of this resolution shall be filed in the offices of the Clerk of the Circuit Court and duly recorded in the public records of St. Johns County, Florida.

4. That the applicant shall pay all recording costs.

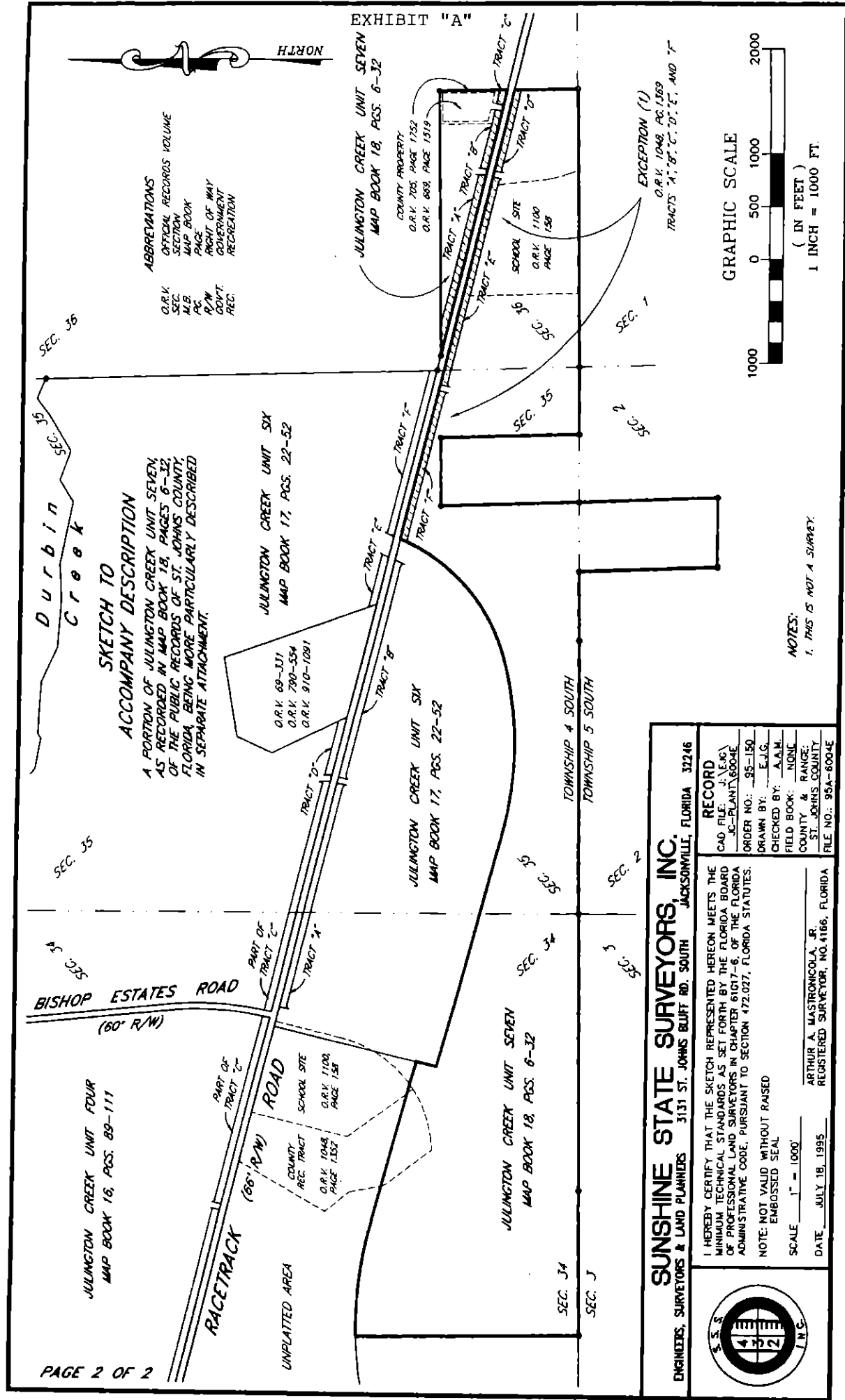


