RESOLUTION NO. 95- 195

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY ESTABLISHING A \$12.50 SURCHARGE ON MOVING TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS WITHIN ST. JOHNS COUNTY TO FUND THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE 800 MH_z COMMUNICATION SYSTEM.

Whereas, In 1993, the Federal Communications Commission granted St. Johns County an 800 MHz Frequency; and

Whereas, The St. Johns County Sheriff's Office currently uses voice communications on a VHF Radio System as their prime dispatch and communication medium; and

Whereas, The 800 MH_Z systems offers a means of relieving voice channel congestion and provides a means of increase efficiency and security when used for a mobile/portable data system; and

Whereas, Florida Statutes 316.655 provides counties with the ability to levy a surcharge on moving traffic violations up to \$12.50 to fund an Intergovernmental Radio Communication Program.

Whereas, the St. Johns County Sheriff's Office and the City of St. Augustine Police Department have developed an intergovernmental radio communications program, and

Whereas, this program may be expanded to include other governmental agencies.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, that effective January 1, 1996, a \$12.50 surcharge be levied on moving traffic violations within St. Johns County and be dedicated for the implementation of an Intergovernmental Radio Communication Program - 800 MHz Communication System. Additionally, the collection and disbursement of these funds will be allocated for such use during the annual budget process of the Board of County Commissioners
