## RESOLUTION 95- 30

RESOLUTION CREATING THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY SESOUICENTENNIAL COORDINATING COMMITTEE; ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FINAL DATE AND APPOINTING MEMBERS ACCORDING TO FLORIDA STATUTE 94-152.

WHEREAS Florida officially became a State of the Union March 3, 1845; and,

WHEREAS March 3, 1995, will be the 150th anniversary of Florida's statehood; and,

WHEREAS, the 1994 Florida Legislature created the Florida Sesquicentennial Commission to plan and coordinate a statewide, year-long celebration of the anniversary; and,

WHEREAS, the State Sesquicentennial Commission has requested the St. Johns County Board of County Commissioners to appoint a Local Sesquicentennial Coordinating Committee to coordinate local events, communicate with the State Commission and comply with all other requirements of F.S. 94-152;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the St. Johns County Sesquicentennial Coordinating Committee shall be created effective this 14 day of February, 1995; the Committee shall automatically dissolve as of January 31, 1996, the final date an annual report shall be due to the State Commission.
