

RESOLUTION NO. 95-64

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA URGING THE CONTINUED APPROPRIATION OF FUNDING FOR PRESERVATION 2000.

WHEREAS, St. Johns County citizens have an interest and concern for the protection of natural lands; and

WHEREAS, Preservation 2000 is a ten-year program designed to acquire and therefore save Florida's best remaining natural land, and is the State's most comprehensive land protection program; and

WHEREAS, Florida's rate of population growth and conversion of natural areas continue to threaten our natural systems; and

WHEREAS, Preservation 2000 is now in the fifth year of operation and has already preserved over 500,000 acres of environmentally sensitive lands; and

WHEREAS, Preservation 2000 offers an opportunity for a partnership between St. Johns County and the State to protect environmentally sensitive lands and support implementation of our County Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County recognizes the importance of Preservation 2000 in enabling the implementation of conservation goals, growth management and comprehensive land use plans.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That the St. Johns County Board of County Commissioners urges the Legislature of the State of Florida to:

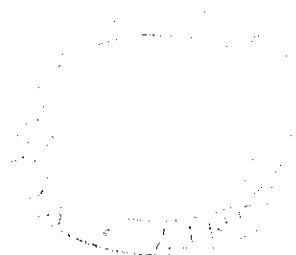
A. Appropriate funding for a sixth series of Preservation 2000 Bonds.
