## RESOLUTION NO. 96-112

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA GRANTING A PERPETUAL EASEMENT OVER CERTAIN COUNTY PROPERTIES MORE FULLY DESCRIBED BELOW, TO THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE WIDENING AND IMPROVEMENT PROJECT TO STATE ROAD 207.

WHEREAS, the State of Florida Department of Transportation proposes to widen and improve State Road No. 207, Section No. 78050-2516 in St. Johns County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that an easement across certain lands now owned by St. Johns County be acquired by the State of Florida Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the St. Johns County Board of County Commissioners has determined that it is in the best interest of St. Johns County to grant this perpetual easement to the Florida Department of Transportation for the widening and improvement project of State Road 207; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida Department of Transportation has made application to St. Johns County to execute and deliver to the State of Florida Department of Transportation an easement in favor of the State of Florida Department of Transportation, for the purpose of clearing, excavating, constructing and maintaining outfall, drainage ditches, drains and water retention areas, and said request having been duly considered.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida as follows:

- Section 1. The application of the State of Florida Department of Transportation for a Perpetual Easement is for transportation purposes which is in the public or community interest and for the public welfare, and the land needed for transportation and other purposes is not needed for County purposes.
- Section 2. An easement in favor of the State of Florida Department of Transportation granting the right to use land described thereon for transportation and other road purposes shall be executed by the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners. Consideration shall be \$1.00. A copy of the proposed easement is attached to this Resolution as Exhibit "A".
- Section 3. A certified copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded forthwith to the State of Florida Department of Transportation District Two, Eminent Domain Department, Post Office Box 1089, 1901 South Marion Street, Lake City, Florida 32056-1089.
- Section 4. The easement to the State of Florida Department of Transportation shall be duly recorded in the official public records of St. Johns County, Florida.

COMMENCE at the Southwest corner of the Daniel Hurlbert Grant, Section 47, Township 7 South, Range 29 East, St. Johns County, Florida; thence North 73°16'27" East along the South line of said Section 47, (North line of the Antonio Canovas Donation, Section 48, Township 7 South, Range 29 East, St. Johns County, Florida), a distance of 1,497.30 feet; thence South 44°38'14" West, a distance of 9.07 feet; thence South 45°21'46" East, a distance of 52.00 feet to the intersection of the Southeasterly right of way line of State Road No. 207, and the Easterly right of way line of Industrial Park Road, (an 80.00 foot right of way), and to a point of intersection with a non-tangent curve concave Westerly having a radius of 659.87 feet; thence Southeasterly along said Northerly right of way line and along the arc of said curve through an angle of 02°26'23", a distance of 28.10 feet, said arc being subtended by a chord bearing and distance of South 40°37'30" East, 28.10 feet; thence South 44°38'14" West, a distance of 35.20 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING, said point being on the arc of a curve concave Westerly having a radius of 624.87 feet; thence Southeasterly and Southerly along the arc of said curve through an angle of 36°26'13", a distance of 397.38 feet, said curve having a chord bearing and distance of South 20°51'04" East, 390.72 feet, to the end of said curve; thence South 02°37'57" East, a distance of 1,586.20 feet to a point on the arc of a curve concave Easterly having a radius of 1,268.57 feet; thence Southerly and Southeasterly along the arc of said curve through an angle of 43°29'49", a distance of 963.06 feet, said curve having a chord bearing and distance of South 24°22'52" East, 940.10 feet, to the end of said curve; thence South 46°07'46" East, a distance of 469.31 feet; thence South 43°52'14" West, a distance of 45.00 feet to a point on the Westerly right of way line of Industrial Park Road (an 80.00 foot right of way); thence North 46°07'46" West along said Westerly right of way line, a distance of 469.31 feet to the beginning of a curve concave Easterly having a radius of 1,313.57 feet; thence Northwesterly and Northerly along the arc of said curve and along said Westerly right of way line through an angle of 43°29'49", a distance of 997.22 feet, said curve having a chord bearing and distance of North 24°22'52" West, 973.44 feet, to the end of said curve; thence North 02°37'57" West along said Westerly right of way line, a distance of 1,586.20 feet to the beginning of a curve concave Westerly having a radius of 579.87 feet; thence Northerly and Northwesterly along the arc of said curve and along said Westerly right of way line through an angle of 35°56'47", a distance of 363.80 feet, said curve having a chord bearing and distance of North 20°36'20" West, 357.86 feet; thence North 44°38'14" East, a distance of 45.29 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING,
