

**RESOLUTION NO. 96 158**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A JOINT PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND ST. JOHNS COUNTY.**

**WHEREAS**, the Florida Department of Transportation has agreed to enter into a Joint Participation Agreement with St. Johns County, a copy of which is attached, incorporated by reference and made a part hereof; and

**WHEREAS**, the County has agreed to the transfer of Vilano Road and Old Vilano Bridge from the State Highway System to the County Road System; and

**WHEREAS**, the County agrees to accept \$110,000 from the Department to perform the work necessary to bring the roadway into compliance with current Department standards; and

**WHEREAS**, the County agrees to bear all expenses in excess of the \$110,000 total estimated cost and any deficits involved.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida as follows:

Section 1. The County Administrator is hereby authorized to execute the above described Joint Participation Agreement with the FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, herein after called FDOT.

Section 2. This Joint Participation Agreement will set forth the financial terms and conditions under which the County and FDOT will abide, commencing on the date of approval by the FDOT's District Secretary.

Section 3. A copy of the Resolution shall be forwarded to FDOT in order to advise them of the County's intent to execute such a Joint Participation Agreement with a representative of the Department.

Section 4. The Clerk is authorized to record the Transfer Agreement and file the Agreement in the public records of St. Johns County, Florida.
