RESOLUTION 97-- 140

A RESOLUTION MODIFYING CERTAIN WEIGH SCALE FEES AND CHARGES PERTAINING TO GARBAGE AND REFUSE DISPOSAL AND ESTABLISHING THE RATE OF THE ANNUAL SOLID WASTE NON-AD VALOREM ASSESSMENT LEVIED PURSUANT TO ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE 89-20, AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS, on May 9, 1989 the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida passed St. Johns County Ordinance No. 89-20; and

WHEREAS, Section 38 of the Ordinance provided that the Board may modify and/or add to fees and charges established therein by resolution(s); and

WHEREAS, Section 45 of the Ordinance provided that the Board may modify the rate of the Special Assessment established therein by resolution(s);

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida as follows:

Section 1. The fees and charges established by subsection A(i) of Section 38 and footnote 2 of section 38 of St. Johns County Ordinance No. 89-20, as previously amended, are hereby modified and established, and shall be charged and collected as follows:

Section 38.

- A. Across Weigh Scales (per ton)²:
- (i) Packer trucks, roll-off containers, front-end loaders and other vehicles and trailers not included or described in A (i), A (ii), A (iii): \$70.00
- In the event the County's weighing scales are out of service, the previous average refuse weights of the trucks will be used to calculate the fees. If average weights are not available, the "per ton" fees will be calculated and charged by estimated cubic yards of disposed materials and said fees shall be \$17.00 per cubic yard for items described in A(i), above, and \$20.00 per cubic yard for items described in A (iv), above.

Section 2. The rate or amount of the Special Assessment levied pursuant to Section 45 of St. Johns County Ordinance 89-20, as amended, shall be \$58.00 for the year 1997 and for each year thereafter until modified by subsequent County resolution or ordinance. Such rate or amount shall be charged, assessed and levied each year on and for each residence, dwelling unit, and habitat, whether occupied or not, ("the unit of measurement") located upon Non Exempt Residential Property on January 1 of the year in which levied; all in the manner provided by St. Johns County Ordinance 89-20, as amended, and Florida Statute 197.3632, and or other applicable law.

Section 3. Section 1 of this resolution shall take effect October 1, 1997. Section 2 of this resolution shall take effect upon adoption.
