A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY TO RECOGNIZE THE "ST. JOHNS COUNTY FIRE SERVICE ADVISORY BOARD" AS REPRESENTING THE INTERESTS OF THE VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS SERVING ST. JOHNS COUNTY

WHEREAS, St. Johns County is in the process of consolidating the sixteen existing volunteer fire departments into a single county-wide fire department; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County that the "St. Johns County Fire Service Advisory Board" shall continue to be recognized as representing the interests and needs of the volunteer firefighters serving St. Johns County.
