RESOLUTION NO. 97-41

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY APPROVING THE ISSUANCE BY THE HOUSING FINANCE AUTHORITY OF CLAY COUNTY OF ITS SINGLE FAMILY MORTGAGE REVENUE BONDS IN THE AGGREGATE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$75,000,000 TO PROVIDE FUNDS TO FINANCE THE PURCHASE OF SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENCES IN VARIOUS COUNTIES WITHIN THE STATE OF FLORIDA, INCLUDING ST. JOHNS COUNTY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Housing Finance Authority of Clay County, Florida (the "Clay Authority") has authorized the initiation of official action to issue its Single Family Mortgage Revenue Bonds (the "Clay Bonds") to provide financing of qualified owner-occupied single family residences to alleviate the shortage of housing in various counties within the State of Florida, including St. Johns County (collectively, the "Counties") by acquiring certain mortgage notes secured by mortgages of real property owned by moderate, middle or lesser income persons or families in the Counties.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Clay County, Florida conducted a Public Hearing on October 8, 1996, notice of which hearing was published on September 20, 1996, in The Florida Times-Union (a copy of which notice is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein), for the purpose of considering the issuance of the Clay Bonds by the Clay Authority in the aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$75,000,000, in conformance with the requirements of Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and the use of a portion of the proceeds thereof to finance single family loans programs within other counties within the State of Florida. Said Public Hearing disclosed no reason why the Clay Bonds should not be issued; and

WHEREAS, the Housing Finance Authority of St. Johns County, Florida conducted a Public Hearing on March 6, 1997, notice of which hearing was published on February 11, 1997, in the St. Johns Record (a copy of which notice is attached hereto as Exhibit "B" and incorporated herein), for the purpose of considering the issuance of the Clay Bonds by the Clay Authority in the aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$75,000,000, in conformance with the requirements of Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and the use of a portion of the proceeds thereof to finance single family loans programs within the County and other counties within the State of Florida. Said Public Hearing disclosed no reason why the Clay Bonds should not be issued.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA (the "Board"):

Section 1. The Board, pursuant to, and in accordance with, the requirements set forth in Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, hereby approves the issuance of the Clay Bonds by the Clay Authority.

Section 2. Pursuant to Section 159.603, Florida Statutes, the operation of the Clay Authority within the territorial boundaries of St. Johns County as described herein, is hereby approved.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
