

RESOLUTION NO 97- 43

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA REQUESTING THAT THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION DESIGNATE HIGHWAY A1A THROUGH ST. JOHNS COUNTY AS A COUNTY SCENIC HIGHWAY AND PROVIDING FOR PLACEMENT OF HISTORIC LANDMARKS ALONG THE HIGHWAY FOR BOTH HISTORIC AND SCENIC DESIGNATIONS

WHEREAS, St. Johns County, Florida, encompasses a wide variety of scenic land and water vistas;  
and

WHEREAS, Highway A1A passes through or by such scenic vistas; and

WHEREAS, the preservation of the picturesque scenic beauty and historical interest of Highway A1A is in the best interest of the citizens of St. Johns County and the State of Florida.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that Highway A1A in St. Johns County, from the Duval County Line south to the Flagler County Line shall henceforth be designated a "St. Johns County Scenic Highway", and shall be marked with appropriate signage and historical landmarks as appropriate.


