

RESOLUTION NO. 97-56

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA SUPPORTING THE PONTE VEDRA MUNICIPAL SERVICE DISTRICT'S REQUEST FOR STATE FUNDING FOR THE PONTE VEDRA DRAINAGE MASTER PLAN

WHEREAS, there exists a serious flooding problem in the Ponte Vedra area; and

WHEREAS, the Ponte Vedra Municipal Service District has taken steps to solve the problem by developing a plan of action based on an Engineering Master Plan and specific recommendations by its consulting engineers; and


WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County has committed \$200,000 to the removal of vegetation, cattails and root mat from the drainage spillway and for implementation of that plan; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida has authorized the pursuit of various financial grants-in-aid programs from federal, state, regional and local sources.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that our legislative delegation be requested to support and approve funding in the State budget for the alleviation of the flooding in Ponte Vedra as requested by the Ponte Vedra Municipal Service District.
