

RESOLUTION NO. 97- 97

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY TO REQUEST A TRANSFER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION PROJECT FUNDS PREVIOUSLY ALLOCATED TO THE HIGHWAY A1A WIDENING PROJECT TO A NEW PROJECT CONSISTING OF EXTENDING HIGHWAY "9-B" (PROPOSED) RIGHT-OF-WAY FROM I-95 SOUTH TO RACE TRACK ROAD, INCLUDING A "CLOVERLEAF" INTERSECTION AT I-95.

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation, District 2 recently accepted a request, made by the St. Johns County Board of County Commissioners, and incorporated in Resolution 97-42, to cease all efforts pertaining to the widening Highway A1A south of Owens Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioner's request has enabled the Florida Department of Transportation, District 2 to conserve the project funding for another suitable project; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has timely identified an alternate project of critical need, suitable for the project funding;


BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County that:

1. The extension of Highway "9-B" (proposed) right-of-way from I-95 south to Race Track Road, including a "cloverleaf" intersection at I-95, is identified as a critically needed highway project in St. Johns County.
2. The project funds dedicated for use in St. Johns County, conserved by the ceased operations in the A1A widening project, are requested to be transferred for use in the Highway "9-B" extension project.


