A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST.
JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING TOURIST DEVELOPMENT
COUNCIL POLICY PERTAINING TO THE BEGINNING AND ENDING
DATES OF TERMS FOR TOC MEMBERS.

WHEREAS, St. Johns County Board of County Commissioners has established the St. Johns County Tourist Development Council as authorized under 125.0104 Florida Statute, and;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has appointed members to serve on the Tourist Development Council for terms of four years as stated in the St. Johns County Tourist Development Council Policy Manual approved and accepted by the Board of County Commissioners January 27, 1997, and;

WHEREAS, the Policy Manual currently requires Tourist Development Council terms to begin on October 1 of the appropriate year, and;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has determined that a January 1 start date for Tourist Development Council terms would be more advantageous to the Board and the County

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

- Terms for future appointments to the Tourist Development Council will begin January 1, and end December 31 of the appropriate year, and;
- Terms of all current members will be extended ninety (90) days, terminating on December 31 of the appropriate year.
