## RESOLUTION NO. 98-185

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA CONFIRMING ITS INTENT TO OPERATE ALL COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES AS THEY PRESENTLY EXIST AND WITHOUT REDUCTION OF CURRENT LEVELS OF SERVICES SUBSEQUENT TO RELOCATION OF SERVICES TO NEW FACILITY

WHEREAS, St. Johns County, Florida has a great need for additional space to house its County Mental Health Services Department in order to serve its rapidly expanding population; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has resolved to purchase and renovate the Flagler Hospital West building located at 1955 U.S. 1 South, St. Augustine, FL 32086, and to house St. Johns County Community Mental Health Services at this location; and

WHEREAS, the County Administrator has been authorized by the Board of County Commissioners to execute a contract for the purchase and renovation of Flagler Hospital West; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners is the current provider of mental health services in St. Johns County by contract with the State of Florida Department of Children and Families

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that community mental health services will continue to be provided:

- 1. In a substantially equivalent manner and level of services as at present, subsequent to relocation to Flagler Hospital West; and
- 2. Through the term of the original CMHC construction grant which expires April 1, 1999; and
- 3. In compliance with all terms of such waiver to be granted by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services.
