## RESOLUTION NO. 98-97

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA REQUESTING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS OR HIS DESIGNEE TO PERMIT VARIATIONS TO THE STANDARDS AND CRITERIA OF THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY ROADWAY AND DRAINAGE ORDINANCE 96-40, AS AMENDED, FOR THE PAVING OF CERTAIN PHYSICALLY EXISTING COUNTY-OWNED SOIL ROADS WITHIN THE ST. AUGUSTINE SOUTH AND NORTH BEACH SUBDIVISIONS USING THE COLD-MIX PROCESS FOR TEST PURPOSES ONLY.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioner of St. Johns County (the "Board") desires to pave County-owned soil roads at the least possible costs to all of the residents of St. Johns County: and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to use certain County-owned roads within the St. Augustine South and North Beach Subdivisions as shown by Exhibits "A and B" as pilot projects for the cold-mix asphalt paving process in order to determine the feasibility of a County-wide program using said process and

WHEREAS, the Board has had independent testing performed and the results indicate the alternative of the cold-mix asphalt paving process conforms to the general intent and spirit of the St. Johns County Roadway and Drainage Ordinance, as amended and

WHEREAS, the St. Johns County Roadway and Drainage Standards Ordinance 96-40 allows variations to the standards and criteria by the Director of Public Works upon showing of good cause and where the Board, (being the Owner/Applicant) proposes an alternative which conforms to the general intent and spirit of said Ordinance and

WHEREAS, the Board has shown good cause in that the costs of said process are substantially less than traditional paving methods and will benefit the residents of the County, therefore serving a public purpose and

WHEREAS, said independent testing and testimony from other Counties using said process have shown the process is an alternative which conforms to the general intent and spirit of said Ordinance

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, respectfully requests that a variation to the standards and criteria of the Roadway and Drainage Standards Ordinance 96-40, as amended, providing for the use of the cold-mix asphalt process on the roads depicted on Exhibits "A and B", be granted by the Director of Public Works or his designee.
