RESOLUTION NO. 99-126

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING A MAP OF STEVEN COLEE ROAD BE FILED WITH THE CLERK OF COURTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH FLORIDA STATUTE 95.361 ROADS PRESUMED TO BE DEDICATED WHEN CONSTRUCTED BY THE COUNTY AND MAINTAINED BY THE COUNTY FOR 4 YEARS THE ROAD SHALL BE VESTED IN ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, Florida Statute 95-361 Roads presumed to be dedicated (see copy attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "A") clearly states the process whereby a road constructed by a county and has been maintained or repaired continuously and uninterruptedly for 4 years by county, the road shall be deemed to be dedicated to the public to the extent in width that has been actually maintained for the prescribed period, whether or not the road has been formerly established as a public highway. The dedication shall vest all right, title, easement, and appurtenances in and to the road in St. Johns County by filing of a map in the office of the clerk of court; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners in Resolution No. 88-73 and Resolution No. 88-89 established a list of roads long considered by the County to be County Roads with little or no documentation of record County ownership; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners in Resolution No. 88-73 and Resolution No. 88-89 instructed staff to obtain documentation in order to document justification for continued County maintenance of said roads; and

WHEREAS, Steven Colee Road as described on (Exhibit "B" attached hereto and made a part hereof and shown on the map Exhibit "C" attached hereto and made a part hereof) is one of the roads considered to be a County Road; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Alma Colee Barlow formerly resided on Steven Colee Road has certified by letter (attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "D") stating that Steven Colee Road was constructed by St. Johns County Road and Bridge Department and the County still maintains the road; and

WHEREAS, The attached Memorandum (attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "E) from Johnny Newsom-Supervisor-Road & Bridge states that Steven Colee has been maintained by the County for the past 24 years, and

WHEREAS, it is the best interest of St. Johns County to acquire ownership of Steven Colee Road for the Benefit of the citizens of St. Johns County.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows

- 1. All the above are findings of fact.
- 2. The Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida hereby authorize the Chairman and Clerk of the Board to execute the attached map of Steven Colee Road to be filed in the Public Records of St. Johns County hereby vesting ownership of Steven Colee Road in St. Johns County in accordance with Florida Statute 95.361 Roads presumed to be dedicated..


95.361 Roads presumed to be dedicated .--


- (1) When a road, constructed by a county, a municipality, or the Department of Transportation, has been maintained or repaired continuously and uninterruptedly for 4 years by the county, municipality, or the Department of Transportation, jointly or severally, the road shall be deemed to be dedicated to the public to the extent in width that has been actually maintained for the prescribed period, whether or not the road has been formally established as a public highway. The dedication shall vest all right, title, easement, and appurtenances in and to the road in:
 - (a) The county, if it is a county road;
 - (b) The municipality, if it is a municipal street or road; or
 - (c) The state, if it is a road in the State Highway System or State Park Road System,
- whether or not there is a record of a conveyance, dedication, or appropriation to the public use.
- (2) The filing of a map in the office of the clerk of the circuit court of the county where the road is located showing the lands and reciting on it that the road has vested in the state, a county, or a municipality in accordance with subsection (1) or by any other means of acquisition, duly certified by:
- (a) The secretary of the Department of Transportation, or the secretary's designee, if the road is a road in the State Highway System or State Park Road System;
- (b) The chair and clerk of the board of county commissioners of the county, if the road is a county road; or
- (c) The mayor and clerk of the municipality, if the road is a municipal road or street,

shall be prima facie evidence of ownership of the land by the state, county, or municipality, as the case may be.

Please use this letter as my certification that I lived on subject road from the time it was built by St. Johns County employees in December 1934 until 1971. At that time I sold part of the property to Henry Cagle and gave my daughter, Jennell Thomas, 10 acres.

For the record: Right-of-Way was given by Ned Colee, Charles & Violet Colee, Stephen & Alma Colee and Joe Sanks in December 1934 to St. Johns County for subject road.

As of this date, the county is still maintaining this road. It should be from CR 208 all the way in front of the Thomas Property. (Stops at the gate). The Thomas family may built on this property in the near future; therefore the reason and urgency to get this problem solved.

Request your help in getting this road property recorded in the St. Johns County records.
