## RESOLUTION NO. 99-181

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA AMENDING THE CURRENT COUNTY ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE BY ADDITION OF CERTAIN FUNDS TO ENHANCE THE SHERIFF'S PROGRAM OF ENFORCEMENT OF COUNTY ORDINANCES REGULATING USE OF THE BEACHES OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY.

## RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, finds that enhanced enforcement of County ordinances regulating the use of the County beaches is in the public interest; and

WHEREAS, the St. Johns County Sheriff has proposed a plan to implement this policy by use of overtime employee hours and other current assets of the Sheriff's Office which can be used on an intermittent basis over the six month period from the date of this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 30.49(8), Florida Statutes, the Sheriff has agreed to amendment of the budget of the Sheriff's Office by addition of up to \$15,000 to cover the costs of this plan that exceed monies previously budgeted for the use of the Sheriff's Office.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that:

- Section 1. The above stated Recitals are incorporated herein and adopted as findings of fact in support of this Resolution.
- Section 2. The County Administrator is hereby directed to amend the budget of the Sheriff's Office by the addition of up to \$15,000 for the enhancement of enforcement of County ordinances regulating the use of County controlled beaches north of the St. Augustine Inlet in St. Johns County.
- Section 3. The sum of up to \$15,000 to fund the above directed budget amendments shall be transferred to the Sheriff's 1999 2000 Budget from the General Reserve Fund of St. Johns County.
