STATING ITS INTENT TO USE THE SECTION 197.3632, FLORIDA STATUTES, UNIFORM METHOD FOR COLLECTING NON AD VALOREM ASSESSMENTS TO LEVY, COLLECT AND ENFORCE THE NON-AD VALOREM SEWAGE FACILITY ASSESSMENTS THAT WILL BE LEVIED ON CERTAIN DESCRIBED REAL PROPERTY THAT IS LOCATED WITHIN THE MUNICIPAL SERVICE DISTRICT OF PONTE VEDRA BEACH; STATING A NEED FOR SUCH LEVY; PROVIDING INSTRUCTIONS TO THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR; PROVIDING THAT THE CLERK SHALL MAIL A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION TO THE TAX COLLECTOR, PROPERTY APPRAISER AND DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida (the "Board") is contemplating the imposition and levying of Non-Ad Valorem Sewage Facility Assessments against real property that is located within the Municipal Service District of Ponte Vedra Beach that will be specially benefited by the construction of the sewage collection and transmission facilities that the Board intends to construct within the District; and

WHEREAS, the Board intends to use the Section 197.3632, Florida Statutes uniform method for collecting non-ad valorem assessments to levy, collect and enforce such Non-Ad Valorem Sewage Facility Assessments commencing as early as the year 2000; and

WHEREAS, the Board held a duly advertised public hearing pertaining to the adoption of this resolution prior to adopting this resolution; proof of publication of such public hearing being attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the St. Johns County Tax Collector and the St. Johns County Property Appraiser have consented to the adoption of this resolution on February 22, 2000 instead of prior to January 1, 2000 and to the mailing of this resolution to the tax collector, property appraiser and the department of revenues by March 10, 2000; copies of said consents being attached hereto as Exhibit B,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

Section 1. Commencing with the Fiscal Year beginning on October 1, 2000 and with the notice of ad valorem taxes and non-ad valorem assessments mailed for such Fiscal Year, the Board intends to use the uniform method for the levy, collection and enforcement of non-ad valorem assessments that is authorized by Section 197.3632, Florida Statutes as amended, to levy collect and enforce the non-ad valorem sewage facility assessments that the Board intends to levy, collect and

enforce against real property that is located within the Municipal Service District of Ponte Vedra Beach that will be specially benefited by the construction of the sewage collection and transmission facilities that the Board intends to construct within the District. A legal description of the boundaries of the real property subject to the levy is attached hereto as <u>Exhibit C</u> and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. The Board hereby finds, determines and states that the levy of the non-ad valorem sewage facility assessments is needed to fund and pay the acquisition, construction, financing, refinancing, loan repayment, and other costs necessary for and associated with the provision of the above described sewage collection and transmission facilities and the collection of the assessments.

Section 3. The County Administrator is hereby instructed to timely provide the property appraiser with the information and assistance that the property appraiser needs in order for the property appraiser to be able to provide to the Board by June 1, 2000 the information set forth in Section 197.3632(3)(b), Florida Statutes.

Section 4. The Clerk is hereby directed to send a copy of this Resolution with Exhibits A, B and C attached to the Florida Department of Revenue, the St. Johns County Tax Collector, and the St. Johns County Property Appraiser by United States mail by March 10, 2000.

Section 5. This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption.

It is my understanding that the Ponte Vedra Beach MSD Sewer Survey conducted by your office indicates that there is a 54% approval majority of those affected by the proposed sewer project. This data results from an approximate 68% survey response. Based on that information, I agree with the St. Johns County Board of County Commissioner's proposal to postpone the adoption of its resolution stating its intent to use the uniform method of collecting non ad valorem assessments to collect the non ad valorem assessments that will be used to finance, or repay the loan used to finance, the sewer project to February 22, 2000. I also concur that the Board may mail a copy of the resolution to the Property Appraiser, Tax Collector and the Department of Revenue by March 10, 2000.

As I stated in my earlier memorandum, the Property Appraiser's office does not administer non-ad valorem assessments. It is a fulltime job for this office to carry out the demands of ad valorem assessment and exemptions. Because of this fact, I am still hesitant to play a part in the decision-making process governing a non-ad valorem assessment that has the potential to significantly impact a portion of St. Johns County residents.

I am certain that the Board of County Commissioners believes that this service is necessary and desired. However, I remain convicted to my belief that if an issue is important enough to merit a special assessment, then it is important enough to go through its due process.

Again, communication and cooperation between all of our departments and offices is important. I am always willing to work together for the greater good of St. Johns County. In the future, I would appreciate being apprised of any issue requiring my approval prior to the decision's having been made.
