

RESOLUTION 2001- 34

**A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE
APPROPRIATION FOR COSTS OF UPGRADING THE WINDLOAD
RESISTANCE OF LOCAL SCHOOLS FOR THEIR USE AS
HURRICANE SHELTERS.**

- WHEREAS**, it is in the public interest to have adequate hurricane shelter space available within the boundaries of St. Johns County; and
- WHEREAS**, the St. Johns County School District agreed to increase the windload construction factor of its new Pedro Menendez High School and its new Bartram Trails High School for this purpose; and
- WHEREAS**, this change in the construction level was made at the request of St. Johns County; and
- WHEREAS**, the School District will make this windload factor improved space available to the County for use as public shelters in times of emergency; and
- WHEREAS**, this windload factor improved space will become a part of the County's Emergency Management response plans; and
- WHEREAS**, it is reasonable that the County share in the cost of the schools to the extent of the cost of the required windload factor improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that:

1. The above Whereas' are adopted as a finding of fact.
2. The amount of \$216,000 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund Reserve to compensate the School District for the cost of the windload factor upgrades at the Pedro Menendez High School and the Bartram Trail High School.
3. Because of the subject school facilities availability as emergency shelters, the \$216,000 hereby appropriated from the General Fund Reserve shall be transferred to the St. Johns County School District.

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

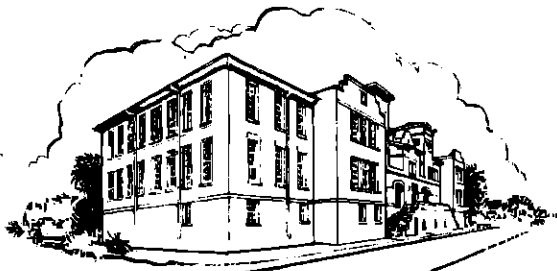

As you are aware, the St. Johns County Board of County Commission voted to fund the hurricane shelter upgrade at our two new high schools (Pedro Menendez and Bartram Trail) at its regular meeting on April 13, 1999. The total amount requested to be paid by the County for the hurricane shelter upgrade was \$216,000 (\$141,000 for Pedro Menendez and \$75,000 for Bartram Trail). Construction on the two new high schools is nearly complete.
