

RESOLUTION NO. 2002-138

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE EXCAVATION AND TRANSPORT OF FILL MATERIAL FROM THE ANDERSON PARK PUD PROPERTY TO THE INTERSTATE 95 CONSTRUCTION SITE FOR THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION INTERSTATE 95 IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, Interstate 95 (I-95) is a major roadway in St. Johns County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Florida Department of Transportation is about to commence a 6 lane improvement to a portion of I-95 in St. Johns County from SR 207 to International Golf Parkway; and

**WHEREAS**, the improvement to I-95 will provide a significant benefit to St. Johns County residents; and

**WHEREAS**, the improvement to I-95 is being expedited by the Florida Department of Transportation as part of an Economic Stimulus Program by the State of Florida; and

**WHEREAS**, fill material is needed to support the I-95 construction project and the source of fill material required for the I-95 construction project needs to be identified in an expeditious manner, and.

**WHEREAS**, Section 2.03.10.B.1.a. and Section 6.04.09.A.1. of the St. Johns County Land Development Code authorizes that Land Excavation and Borrow Area activities requested by a governmental agency or an Applicant under the permission of another governmental agency may be considered exempt from the requirements of the Land Excavation and Borrow Area regulations with the permission of the Board of County Commissioners.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County that Anderson Columbia may begin excavation and removal of fill material from the Anderson Park PUD property subject to the following conditions:

1. The fill material removed from the site is to be used exclusively for the I-95 construction project in St. Johns County.

2. Anderson Columbia shall file for Site Plan approval by St. Johns County as soon as reasonably possible.

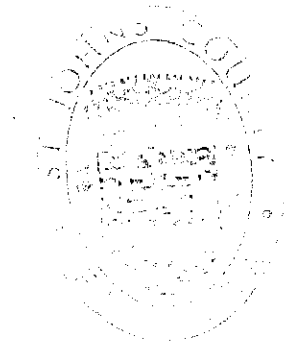

Dear Chairman Bryant:

The purpose of this letter is to inform the St Johns County Board of County Commissioners that Anderson Columbia Co., Inc. is the successful low bidder for the six laning of a portion of I 95 in St Johns County. The starting point of this project is at a point just south of the interchange at SR 207 and I 95 and proceeds north approximately 12.1 miles to a point just south of the interchange of I 95 with International Golf Parkway.


The project will require approximately 120,000 cubic yards of fill material. This material will be used in the median to build the new inside lanes and will be brought in from an off- site location. There are two possible sources for this fill material. One is on CR 208 and situated on property owned by Rayonier Timber Company, a few miles west of I 95. The other is the Anderson Park PUD on SR 16. The contractor will be starting this project on July 8, 2002 and will begin hauling the fill material in August 2002. The contractor should be through with this hauling operation by the end of the year.

Your approval for the use of either the CR 208 site or the Anderson Park PUD by Anderson Columbia will be greatly appreciated by the Florida Department of Transportation and will expedite the construction of this very needed project.

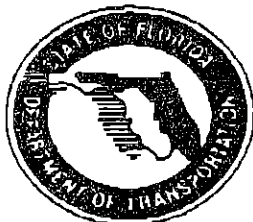
