RESOLUTION NO. 2002-<u>152</u>

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CLERK OF THE COURTS TO FILE THE SURVEY MAP OF A PART OF BROUGH ROAD AND MEADOWBROOK ROAD CLAIMING A VESTED INTEREST IN ST. JOHNS COUNTY IN THE RIGHTS-OF-WAY DESCRIBED IN THIS SURVEY BY PRESCRIPTIVE RIGHTS OF THE PUBLIC IN ACCORD WITH THE PRINCIPLES SET FORTH IN <u>DOWNING V. BIRD</u>, 100 SO.2D 57 (FLA. 1950)

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, adopted County Resolution No. 88-73 which established a list of roads long considered to be County Roads with little or no documentation of recorded County ownership; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, pursuant to County Resolution No. 88-73, has instructed County Staff to obtain documentation in order to justify continued County maintenance of said roads; and

WHEREAS, part of Brough Road and Meadowbrook Road, as described in Exhibit A, attached hereto, and incorporated herein, are two of the roads that County staff has documented as warranting continued County maintenance; and

WHEREAS, in <u>Downing v. Bird</u>, 100 So.2d 57 (Fla. 1950), the Florida Supreme Court set forth criteria for the public to establish a prescriptive easement; and

WHEREAS, the criteria set forth in <u>Downing v. Bird</u>, <u>supra</u>, is as follows:

- 1) actual, continuous uninterrupted use by the public entity for the full prescriptive period of twenty (20) years;
- 2) that the use be adverse under a claim of right, and either be with the actual knowledge of the owner, or so open, notorious, and visible that knowledge of the use is imputed to the owner;
- that such use be inconsistent with the owner's use and enjoyment of his land and must not be a permissive use; and
- 4) that such use be related to a certain limited and defined area of land, or if for a right-of-way, the use be of a definite route with a reasonably certain line, width, and termini; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County can demonstrate that Part of Brough Road and Meadowbrook Road meets each of the criteria, set forth in <u>Downing v. Bird</u>, <u>supra</u>; and

WHEREAS, the public has been continuously using Part of Brough Road and Meadowbrook Road without permission of the underlying land owners for in excess of twenty (20) years; and

WHEREAS, County Road and Bridge Supervisor, Harold Cooper and Johnny Newsome, have stated in two separate memos (Exhibit B, attached hereto, and incorporated herein), that the County has been responsible for maintaining Brough Road and Meadowbrook Road for the last thirty (30) years; and

WHEREAS, by filing the survey map with the Clerk of the Courts of St. Johns County, the rights-of-way as shown in the survey that is included as Exhibit C, attached hereto, and incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of St. John's County to acquire ownership of Part of Brough Road and Meadowbrook Road, and that such acquisition will benefit the citizens of St. Johns County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY **COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:**

The above recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of Section 1. this Resolution, and such recitals are adopted as findings of fact.

The Chair of the Board of County Commissioners, and the Clerk of Section 2. the Courts are hereby authorized to file the attached survey map of Part of Brough Road and Meadowbrook Road in the Public Records of St. Johns County, Florida.

The Clerk is instructed to record this Resolution in the Public Section 3. Records of St. Johns County, Florida.


