

RESOLUTION 2002 - 50

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE WEST AUGUSTINE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY STEERING COMMITTEE ON THE NAMING OF THE WEST AUGUSTINE "STREETSCAPE" BEAUTIFICATION PROJECT, DECLARING ITS NAMING TO BE IN CONFORMANCE WITH RESOLUTION 99-152 AND APPROVING THE "STREETCAPE" NAME.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County partnered with the West Augustine Community Redevelopment Agency Steering Committee in the development of a one mile-long water conservation demonstration "Streetscape" project along West King Street stretching from Park Avenue to Volusia Avenue in West Augustine; and

WHEREAS, this project is the first Florida-friendly beautification landscape and water conservation "Streetscape" demonstration project of its kind that has been completed; and

WHEREAS, a nine year-old child of the neighborhood, named Jasmine, fought a long and arduous battle against a terminal disease; and

WHEREAS, in her untimely death of one year ago, Jasmine left behind a legacy of hope, pride, courage and beautiful spirit that will inspire and not be forgotten by her community; and

WHEREAS, the love that Jasmine had for West Augustine remains in the minds of those who knew her; and

WHEREAS, the West Augustine Community Redevelopment Agency Steering Committee has recommended that this "Streetscape" be named in her memory; and


WHEREAS, it is appropriate that, in accordance with County Resolution 99-152, this "Streetscape" is named.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA that

1. The above recitals are hereby adopted as findings of fact.
2. The "Streetscape" project in the West Augustine area, in accordance with the recommendation of the West Augustine Community Redevelopment Agency Steering Committee, is officially identified as "Jasmine's Way".
3. The naming of this "Streetscape" is in conformance with the requirements for naming County facilities adopted in County Resolution 99-152.


