A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE FLORIDA BOATER IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (A.K.A. FBIP) FOR PHASE I DESIGN, ENGINEERING AND PERMITTING OF IMPROVEMENTS TO PALMO BOAT RAMP. PROVIDING FOR THE IDENTIFICATION OF THE KEY CONTACT PERSON.

WHEREAS, the State's Florida Boater Improvement grant program, administered by the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission is accepting applications from local governments to improve access to State waterways; and

WHEREAS, this grant program was established to assist local governments to design and construct improvements to access; and

WHEREAS, the grant application requires approval of the Board of County Commissioners, and identification of the Key Contact person,

1. The County Administrator is authorized to execute the grant application to be submitted to the Florida Boater Improvement Program.

2. It is further resolved that Shorty Merritt, Administrative Manager, Department of Recreation and Parks is authorized to act as the Key Contact person on behalf of St. Johns County.
