RESOLUTION NO. 2002-80

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM THE GENERAL FUND RESERVE AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Board of County Commissioners has supported the establishment of State Road 13 as the William Bartram Scenic & Historic Highway, and directed staff in February 2002 to expedite the Eligibility Application for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Eligibility Application was presented to the BCC today; and

WHEREAS, an essential component in the FDOT Scenic Highways Program is the development of a Corridor Management Plan (CMP); and

WHEREAS, the development of the CMP had been anticipated to begin in Fiscal Year 2003, and the budget proposal for the Planning Department contains a request in the amount of \$30,000 to fund the development of the CMP; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the CMP has been estimated to be approximately \$80,000, and an opportunity has arisen for FDOT funds to be received in Fiscal Year 2002 which would allow staff to select and engage a consultant to develop the CMP immediately, eliminating the need for the amount in Fiscal Year 2003; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that \$30,000 shall be transferred from the General Fund Reserve (0083-59920) to the Planning Department (0018-53120) to provide funds in addition to those of the FDOT for the development of a Corridor Management Plan for the William Bartram Scenic & Historic Highway (SR 13).
