

**RESOLUTION NO. 2003-65**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING IMPLEMENTATION OF THE ST. JOHNS VISION STRATEGIC PLAN.**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners is a founding partner in the establishment of the countywide strategic planning process, known as, St. Johns Vision; and

**WHEREAS**, The process resulted in the development of a Strategic Plan with 165 strategies in six Foundations to improve Economic Development, Government, Education, Private Sector Leadership, Infrastructure and Quality of Life in St. Johns County; and

**WHEREAS**, the process involves a diverse group from across St. Johns County and the resulting Strategic Plan is based on community involvement and input; and

**WHEREAS**, The Board of County Commissioners directed that in addition to crafting the strategic plan, a specific course of action for implementing the plan be included; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners understands that implementation will require unprecedented cooperation by an alliance of government, private business and service organizations, and that implementation is the necessary bridge between planning a better tomorrow and actually building it; and

**WHEREAS**, broad alliances between the private sector and government can leverage a greater benefit for our community, and increase mutual understanding of the challenges we face and the steps necessary to overcome them; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners has determined that ongoing support of the process is a proper public purpose in the interest of its citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, St. Johns Vision has committed itself to compliance with all existing applicable laws and regulations;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners that St. Johns County departments be encouraged to participate with citizens in the implementation process of the Strategic Plan, to the extent that such participation complies with all laws and regulations and does not detract from the execution of official duties.
