A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING A QUIT CLAIM DEED FOR ADDITIONAL RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR RELOCATION OF A ROADSIDE DITCH ON OLD DIXIE HIGHWAY.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Florida Power & Light Company, a Florida Corporation, has executed and presented to St. Johns County a Quit Claim Deed, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", incorporated by reference and made a part hereof, for additional right-of-way for Old Dixie Highway; and

WHEREAS, the additional right-of-way is needed due to construction of a condominium on Old Dixie Highway located across from Florida Power & Light Company's property. Construction of the condominium requires widening of the pavement to accommodate turn lanes to be installed. The construction forced the existing roadside ditch out to the right-of-way line which caused the ditch sides to be very steep and close to the new edge of pavement; and

WHEREAS, this additional right-of-way will allow St. Johns County to relocate the ditch or change the ditch side slopes for a safer roadway section as stated in a memo from the St. Johns County Development Review Department attached hereto as Exhibit "B", incorporated by reference and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the County to accept this Quit Claim Deed for the safety and well being of the citizens traveling on Old Dixie Highway.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida as follows:

Section 1. The above recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution and such recitals are adopted as findings of fact.

Section 2. The Board of County Commissioners hereby accepts the Quit Claim Deed for the additional right-of-way and the Clerk of Circuit Court is instructed to record the original Quit Claim Deed in the Public Records of St. Johns County.



The quit-claim deed for ten (10) feet off the frontage of the substation site is for additional right of way.

What prompted the need for additional right of way is road construction associated with the condominium project across Old Dixie from FPL's site. The pavement was widened to accommodate turn lanes in Old Dixie. This construction forced the existing, westerly roadside ditch out to the right of way line. The reworked roadside ditch sides are now very steep and the ditch is very close to the new edge of pavement.

This additional right of way from FPL will allow us to relocate the ditch or change the ditch side slopes for a safer roadway section.
