## **RESOLUTION 2004** - 111

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING ALLOCATION AND DISBURSEMENT OF A PORTION OF THE ADOPTED FY04 BUDGET USING TRANSPORTATION BOND REVENUE TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION - DISTRICT 2 FOR TWO LOCALLY FUNDED AGREEMENTS (LFAs) AND AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRPERSON OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY TO EXECUTE BOTH AGREEMENTS.

WHEREAS, St. Johns County has established transportation project funding allocations using Transportation Bond Revenue per the adopted FY 2004 Budget; and,

WHEREAS, the County, when preparing the budget for Fiscal Year 2004, allocated Bond Revenue funding for two (2) Locally Funded Agreements (LFAs) with Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) – District 2 for Project Development & Environmental (PD&E) engineering studies and Engineering Design within the County to be conducted during FY04; and.

WHEREAS, the subject projects are <u>SR 312 Extension from SR 207 to US 1 North</u> (FDOT Financial Project ID #'s 210230-2-22-01 and 210230-2-32-01) to receive a PD&E Study and Engineering Design, and, <u>Major Interchange Improvements for US 1 at CR 210</u> (FDOT Financial Project ID #210420-7-22-01) to receive a PD&E Study only. County funding matches are \$2,000,000 for the SR 312 Project and \$400,000 for the U.S. 1 at CR 210 project; and,

WHEREAS, for each of the two FDOT Projects listed, funds are to be disbursed directly to the FDOT and thereafter will be deposited into separate interest-bearing escrow accounts to be established by the FDOT at the State of Florida Department of Financial Services, Division of Treasury, Bureau of Collateral Management; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to the date specified in the LFAs, funds are be furnished to the FDOT – District 2 on or before June 15, 2004.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida (Board), that:

- 1. The above recitals are hereby adopted as findings of fact.
- 2. The FY04 Transportation Bond revenue and expenditure budgets shall be adjusted to account for allocation of \$2,400,000 for County funding matches of the three (3) FDOT Financial Project ID #s
- 3. Said funds totaling \$2,400,000 shall be disbursed to the FDOT District 2 on or before June 15, 2004.
- 4. The Chairperson of the Board is authorized to execute (on behalf of the County), both Locally Funded Agreements (LFAs)
