

RESOLUTION NO. 2004-116

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA SUPPORTING A NATIONAL CEMETERY TO BE LOCATED AT A SITE THAT WILL SERVE THE LARGEST NUMBER OF VETERANS IN NORTHEAST FLORIDA.**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County (the Board) is aware that a proposal had been made for a National Cemetery to be located in Northeast Florida; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board wishes to support the proposed National Cemetery located in Northeast Florida.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County that:

1. The Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County (the "Board") supports the proposal to have a National Cemetery located at a site that will serve the largest number of veterans in Northeast Florida.


