WHEREAS, this lease agreement will include the space the VA Medical Center has been leasing plus the additional space that is being renovated for their lab area and specialty treatments with a total of 8,277 square feet; and

WHEREAS, in the lease agreement the rent per square foot will be increased by 3% each year; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of St. Johns County have benefited from this agency and the additional space will be able to accommodate their needs.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, as follows:
