RESOLUTION 2004 - <u>93</u>

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING PATIENT-CENTERED HEALTH NETWORK (PCHN) APPLICATION TO OBTAIN FEDERALLY QUALIFIED HEALTH CENTER STATUS FOR THE HASTINGS AREA.

WHEREAS, Hastings and Southwest St. Johns County is a medically underserved area and a health provider shortage area due to its demographics; and

WHEREAS, Hastings and Southwest St. Johns County's major industry is agriculture and the work force is predominately migrant workers; and

WHEREAS, Top health disparity indicators such as infant mortality, low birth weight, teen pregnancy, diabetes, cancer and stroke death rate for western St. Johns County score 92 out of 100, demonstrating a clear need for expanded healthcare services; and

WHEREAS, Dr. S.S. Marathe's Medical Specialists Group has partnered with St. Johns County to provide limited medical services to the area and the current Hastings Medical Center site is not adequately visible and a new expanded site is needed to add additional services that are planned; and

WHEREAS, it is desirous for St. Johns County and Medical Specialists to seek grants and other resources to expand medical services for the area; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County already provides \$200,000 in cash and in-kind contribution to Medical Specialists for medical services in Hastings.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that:

- 1. The above Recitals are hereby adopted as findings of fact.
- 2. St. Johns County supports Patient-Centered Health Network in seeking a Federally Qualified Health Center in Southwest St. Johns County.
