A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, DECLARING THE PUBLIC PURPOSE AND PUBLIC NECESSITY FOR EXERCISING THE RIGHT AND POWER OF EMINENT DOMAIN TO ACQUIRE CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY CONSISTING OF TWO FEE SIMPLE PARCELS AS DESCRIBED BELOW FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A COUNTY ROADWAY; DIRECTING THE COUNTY ATTORNEY TO INSTITUTE CONDEMNATION PROCEEDINGS.

WHEREAS, the County of St. Johns ("County") is authorized to exercise the right and power of eminent domain for certain public uses and purposes; and

WHEREAS, the County's exercise of this power to condemn real property for the purpose of the construction of a county roadway is a proper public purpose;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida that:

Section 1. <u>Declaration of Necessity</u>. The County declares the public necessity for acquiring, through condemnation by right of eminent domain, fee simple title in the real property identified in the attached Exhibit A for the construction of a county roadway.

Section 2. <u>Acquisition of Fee Simple Title</u>. The County shall acquire, through condemnation by right of eminent domain, fee simple title in the real property identified in the attached Exhibit A for the above-referenced public purposes from the owner and any other persons required by law to be joined in such proceedings.

Section 3. <u>Institution of Legal Proceedings</u>. The County Attorney is directed to institute legal proceedings to acquire, through condemnation by right of eminent domain, fee simple title in the real property identified in the attached Exhibit A.
