A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING AND CORRECTING LEGAL DESCRIPTION AND BOUNDARIES OF VILANO BEACH STREET LIGHTING DISTRICT TO REFLECT INTRACOASTAL WATERWAY AS WESTERN BOUNDARY THEREOF; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on November 12, 1968, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, by Resolution (hereinafter referred to as the "1968 Resolution") created a special tax district known as Vilano Beach Street Lighting District; and

WHEREAS, the Camachee Cove Marina and Neighborhood are within the boundaries of the legal description contained in the 1968 Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Vilano Beach Street Lighting District does not service the Camachee Cove Marina and Neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County has determined that a public purpose is served by amending the legal description of the Vilano Beach Street Lighting District to delete the Camachee Cove area from its boundaries and to provide for the western boundary to be the Intracoastal Waterway.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, as follows:

- 1. The above 'Whereas' clauses are accepted as legislative findings of fact and are incorporated by reference herein.
- 2. The Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County approves amending the legal description of the Vilano Beach Street Lighting District to delete the Camachee Cove area from its boundaries.
- 3. The Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County hereby adopts the legal description attached hereto as Exhibit A as the legal description of the Vilano Beach Street

Lighting District.
