RESOLUTION 2006-157

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA INCREASEING THE MAXIMUM PER UNIT AWARD OF THE STATE HOUSING INITIATIVES PARTNERSHIP (SHIP) HOMEBUYER-NEW, HOMEBUYER EXISTING, PURCHASE ASSISTANCE SUBSIDY AND NON-PROFIT DEVELOPER STRATEGIES OF THE LOCAL HOUSING ASSISTANCE PLAN; AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Florida Housing Finance Corporation, Rule 67-37.006 requires that amendments to an approved Local Housing Assistance Plan require adoption by resolution;

WHEREAS, the St. Johns County Board of County Commissioners on July 13, 2004 reviewed and approved the Local housing Assistance Plan for fiscal years, 2002/03, 2003/04 and 2004/05 and on June 1, 2005 reviewed and approved the Local Housing Assistance Plan for fiscal years, 2005/06, 2006/2007 and 2007/2008 by motion; and

WHEREAS, the St. Johns County SHIP Program will be in compliance with the Florida Housing Finance Corporation Rule 67-37.006 upon adoption of this resolution;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that:

- 1. The above recitals are hereby adopted as legislative findings of fact.
- 2. In consideration of the above recitals, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County approves the increase of the maximum per unit award amount for the Homebuyer-New, Homebuyer-Existing and Purchase Assistance Subsidy strategies of the approved Local Housing Assistance Plan, in compliance with Florida Housing Corporation Rule.
- 3. The maximum per unit award for the Homebuyer-New and Homebuyer-Existing strategies is being increased to up to \$50,000 for very-low income homebuyers and up to \$40,000 for low income homebuyers, effective upon adoption of this resolution.
- 4. The maximum per unit award for the Purchase Assistance Subsidy strategy is being increased to up to \$30,000 for very-low income homebuyers and up to \$25,000 for low income homebuyers, effective upon adoption of this resolution.
- 5. The maximum per unit award for the Non-Profit Developer strategy is being increased to *up to* \$30,000 for very-low income homebuyers and *up to* \$20,000 for low income homebuyers, effective upon adoption of this resolution.
- 6. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County.
