

RESOLUTION NO. 2006- 188

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, REVALIDATING CONDITIONS PERTAINING TO COASTAL EROSION.**

**WHEREAS**, on Friday, May 12, 2006, at approximately 1:00 p.m., Chairman James E. Bryant called an emergency meeting of the Board of County Commissioners finding that an emergency existed pertaining to coastal erosion; and

**WHEREAS**, areas of St. Johns County have experienced a “coastal storm,” as referenced in Rule 62B-33.0051(5), Florida Administrative Code, commencing on or about May 8, 2006, which has caused erosion of the Atlantic Ocean beach and dune system in St. Johns County, Florida; and

**WHEREAS**, as a result of such “coastal storm,” certain beach front homes located within St. Johns County have become vulnerable to damage or collapse (the “emergency conditions”) from ongoing ocean wave action or from a subsequent “coastal storm;” and

**WHEREAS**, County staff, including a well qualified Professional Engineer, licensed in the State of Florida, have reinspected the area in question and continues to exists in St. Johns County, as referenced in said Rule 62B-33.0051(5), Florida Administrative Code; and

**WHEREAS**, Rule 62B-33.0051(5), Florida Administrative Code, allows emergency protection to take place within 30 days of the initial storm event causing the emergency, which may be extended 30 days upon revalidation of emergency conditions.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, as follows:

Section 1. The aforementioned recitals are hereby incorporated by reference as findings of fact and conclusions of law.

Section 2. The Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, revalidates the emergency conditions in St. Johns County of the type referenced in Rule 62B-33.0051(5), Florida Administrative Code.
