RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA ACCEPTING GRANT OF DRAINAGE EASEMENT TO ALLOW ACCESS UNDER RAILROAD AVENUE TO INSTALL DRAINAGE CULVERTS AS PART OF THE WEST KING STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT.

### **RECITALS**

WHEREAS, the owner of property (Block R, Lot 23) located adjacent to Railroad Avenue has executed and presented to the County, a Grant of Drainage Easement, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", incorporated by reference and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the easement is needed for the West King Street Improvement Project to improve drainage in the West Augustine area; and

**WHEREAS**, this Grant of Drainage Easement gives permission of an adjacent property owner to the County to install and maintain drainage structures as needed at the Railroad Avenue and King Street intersection; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interest of the County to accept this Grant of Drainage Easement to ensure proper drainage for the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens in that area.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, as follows:

- **Section 1**. The above Recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution and such Recitals are adopted as findings of fact.
- **Section 2**. The Grant of Drainage Easement is hereby accepted in the form attached hereto.
- **Section 3**. The Clerk is instructed to record the original Grant of Drainage Easement in the Official Records of St. Johns County, Florida.

## **GRANT OF DRAINAGE EASEMENT**



WITNESSETH: That Grantor, for and in consideration of the benefit that Grantor will receive, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has granted and conveyed to the Grantee, its successors and assigns, an ingress and egress easement with the right, privilege, and authority to said Grantee, its successors and assigns, to drain surface waters either above or below the surface of the ground, together with the right to install and maintain drainage structures, on, along, over, through, across, or under the following described land situate in St. Johns County, Florida to wit:

#### **EXHIBIT "A"**

A portion of Railroad Avenue (a 40.00 foot Platted Right of Way), College Park Institute Subdivision, according to the plat thereof as recorded in Map Book 3, Page 22, of the Current Public Records of St. Johns County, Florida, lying in Section 45, Township 7 South, Range 29 East, of said St. Johns County, Florida, being more particularly described as follows:

BEGIN at the intersection of the Existing Northwesterly right of way line of Railroad Avenue (a 40.00 foot platted right of way) with the Existing Southwesterly right of way line of County Road No. 214 (West King Street) (a right of way of varying width); Thence South 85°57′31″ East, along the Southeasterly prolongation of the Existing Southwesterly right of way line of said County Road No. 214 (West King Street), a distance of 57.66 feet to its intersection with the Existing Southeasterly right of way line of said Railroad Avenue, said intersection also being a point on the Northwesterly right of way line of Florida East Coast Railway (a 100.00 right of way); Thence South 50°07′08″ West, departing said existing Southwesterly right of way line of County Road No. 214, along said Existing Southeasterly right of way line of Railroad Avenue and the said existing Northwesterly right of way line of Florida East Coast Railway, a distance of 80.06 feet; Thence North 04°02′33″ East, departing said existing Southeasterly right of way line of Railroad Avenue and said existing Northwesterly right of way line of Railroad Avenue and said existing Northwesterly right of way line of Railroad Avenue and said existing Northwesterly right of way line of Railroad Avenue and said existing Northwesterly right of way line of Railroad Railway, a distance of 55.53 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.
