

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-98

A RESOLUTION OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA,  
ADOPTING AN IMPROVED GIS VERSION OF THE ZONING  
ATLAS AS THE COUNTY'S OFFICIAL ZONING ATLAS

WHEREAS, the St. Johns County Land Development Code, Ordinance 99-21 as amended, Article II, Section 2.01.02.A states that the unincorporated portion of St. Johns County is divided by the Code into zoning districts, the boundaries and designations of which are shown on a series of maps, presently covering the entire unincorporated area of St. Johns County, and identified as the Official Zoning Atlas of St. Johns County, hereafter "Official Zoning Atlas"; and

WHEREAS, the geographic information systems (GIS) version of the Official Zoning Atlas, currently maintained by St. Johns County and accurately representing zoning districts, institutes an improved mapping format, represents a dramatic improvement by enabling staff to more quickly and accurately determine the zoning designation of any particular parcel, and will allow members of the public to determine zoning through the County's online information system.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida that St. Johns County adopt the GIS version of the Zoning Atlas as the County's Official Zoning Atlas effective upon the adoption date of this Resolution.
