WHEREAS, the St. Johns County Land Development Code (LDC) at Section 6.02.03.D and Section 336.05, Florida Statutes, provides that the Board of County Commissioners has the authority to rename roads, except State roads designated by number by the FDOT, lying outside the boundaries of any incorporated municipality; and

WHEREAS, the LDC provides procedures for naming and renaming roads at the Board of County Commissioners' initiative; and

WHEREAS, the subject roadway was previously renamed through Resolution 2005-123 following the procedure outlined in Resolution 92-65; however, Resolution 92-65 did not provide for the instance where a property owner of a road would necessarily receive notice; and

WHEREAS, Bryan Joseph Tutten, a native of St. Johns County, enlisted in the United States Army in April, 2002, completed paratrooper training, and was assigned to the world renowned 82nd Airborne Division; and

WHEREAS, Sgt. Tutten was deployed in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom in 2003-2004; and

WHEREAS, after his return from his first tour support Operation Iraqi Freedom, Sgt. Tutten was assigned to a task force in support of assistance in the aftermath of Hurricane Katrina in 2005; and

WHEREAS, Sgt. Tutten was selected for deployment to Iraq in November of 2006 for a tour of duty which was extended to 15 months; and

WHEREAS, in June, 2007, Sgt. Tutten returned to Iraq for a subsequent tour of duty scheduled to conclude in February, 2008; and

WHEREAS, on December 25, 2007, Sgt. Tutten gave his life in service to his country when he was killed in action in Iraq, after receiving wounds from a roadside bomb, and

WHEREAS, Sgt. Tutten's awards and decorations include the Bronze Star Medal, the Purple Heart, the Army Good Conduct Medal with two gold loops, the

Intlet-P. Halternan M+R

National Defense Service Medal, the Iraq Campaign Medal, the Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, the Army Service Ribbon, the Combat Infantryman's Badge, and the Parachutists' Badge; and

WHEREAS, Sgt. Tutten has joined his father, Tom Tutten, the late St. Augustine guitarist and folk singer, who gave his life while coming to the aid of endangered children off of Vilano Beach in St. Johns County; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and in the public interest to memorialize the name of Sgt. Tutten as a role model and hero in St. Johns County, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds it to be in the public interest to change the name of the roadway currently known as Whetstone Place to Sgt. Tutten Drive; and

WHEREAS, the Whetstone Building property has an entrance roadway which leads into it; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has found it to be in the public interest to recognize said entrance roadway as Whetstone Place;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida that, effective immediately:

- 1. The roadway formerly known as Coke Road and then Whetstone Place is hereby renamed to Sgt. Tutten Drive;
- 2. The entrance roadway to the Whetstone Building located at the intersection of State Road 312 and Sgt. Tutten Drive is hereby recognized as Whetstone Place.
