**A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF  
ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE TERMS,  
PROVISIONS, CONDITIONS, AND REQUIREMENTS OF A FLORIDA  
DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION INNOVATIVE  
WASTE REDUCTION GRANT EXTENSION FOR RECYCLING  
PROGRAMS IN ST. JOHNS COUNTY PARKS, AND AUTHORIZES THE  
COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE THE EXTENSION ON  
BEHALF OF THE COUNTY**

**WHEREAS**, the St. Johns County Department of Recreation and Parks applied for and received a 2007 Florida Department of Environmental Protection Innovative Waste Reduction Grant to institute a recycling program in parks located in St. Johns County, Florida; and

**WHEREAS**, the Grantee's project has proved to be more cost effective and money can extend to continue the program; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Grantee has requested an extension to March 30, 2010 to ensure the completion of the project; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Department has agreed to grant the extension; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The above Recitals are hereby incorporated into the body of this Resolution, and are adopted as Findings of Fact.

Section 2. The Board of County Commissioners hereby approves the terms, provisions, conditions, and requirements of a Florida Department of Environmental Protection Innovative Waste Reduction Grant Extension and authorizes the County Administrator to execute the Extension on behalf of the County.

AMENDMENT NO. 1

WHEREAS, the Department has agreed to grant the extension; and,


NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree as follows:
