

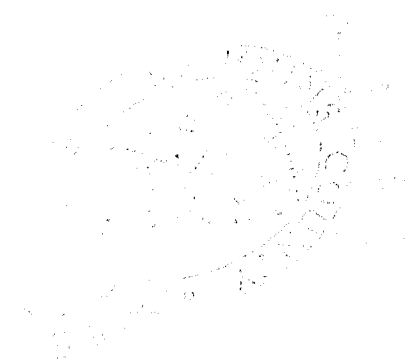
RESOLUTION NO. 2008- 174
