RESOLUTION NO. 2009- 24

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, NAMING AN UNNAMED ROAD TO BARTOLA GENOVAR ROAD LYING IMMEDIATELY NORTH OF THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES CENTER BETWEEN US HIGHWAY 1 AND OLD MOULTRIE ROAD; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the St. Johns County Land Development Code (LDC) at Section 6.02.03.D and Section 336.05, Florida Statutes, provides that the Board of County Commissioners has the authority to rename roads, except State roads designated by number by the FDOT, lying outside the boundaries of any incorporated municipality; and

WHEREAS, the LDC provides procedures for naming and renaming roads at the Board of County Commissioners' initiative; and

WHEREAS, the subject roadway has been unnamed since its original construction in 1979; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 2006-71, recorded in Official Records 2675, Page 520, was adopted by the Board of County Commissioners on March 21, 2006 establishing the Right of Way of said unnamed road; and

WHEREAS, Bartola Genovar, a native of St. Johns County, served in Company B, 3rd Confederate Florida Infantry from August 1861 through April 1865; and

WHEREAS, Bartola Genovar, after the war, opened a grocery store on Charlotte Street in St. Augustine and continued to serve the citizens of St. Augustine and St. Johns County; and

WHEREAS, Bartola Genovar built and operated the first opera house in St. Johns County and promoted culture throughout Northeast Florida by also opening the LaVilla Opera House in Jacksonville; and

WHEREAS, historical records indicate Bartola Genovar was one of the longest serving members of the County Commission for over 30 years, being Chairman for many of those years; and

WHEREAS, Bartola Genovar's name appears on the cornerstone to the 1907 Courthouse that was located on Charlotte and Treasury Streets with said cornerstone being rededicated in 1999 in the Courtyard of the Richard O. Watson Judicial Center; and

WHEREAS, In 1924 Bartola Genovar purchased 300 acres of land lying south of St. Augustine in the area known as Old Lopez Landing which is the area the unnamed road serves; and

WHEREAS, Descendents of Bartola Genovar eventually conveyed the land to the corporation that established and constructed the building that now houses the St. Johns County Health and Human Services Center; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and in the public interest to memorialize the name of Bartola Genovar; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has found it to be in the public interest to name this road in furtherance of the public health, safety and welfare;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida that, effective immediately:

That unnamed road lying immediately north of the St. Johns County Health and Human Services Center located at 1955 U.S. 1 South, lying between US Highway 1 and Old Moultrie Road, is hereby named and shall hereafter be known as BARTOLA GENOVAR ROAD.



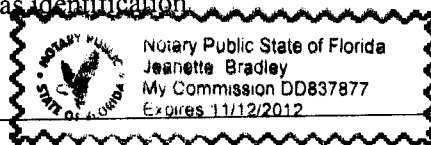

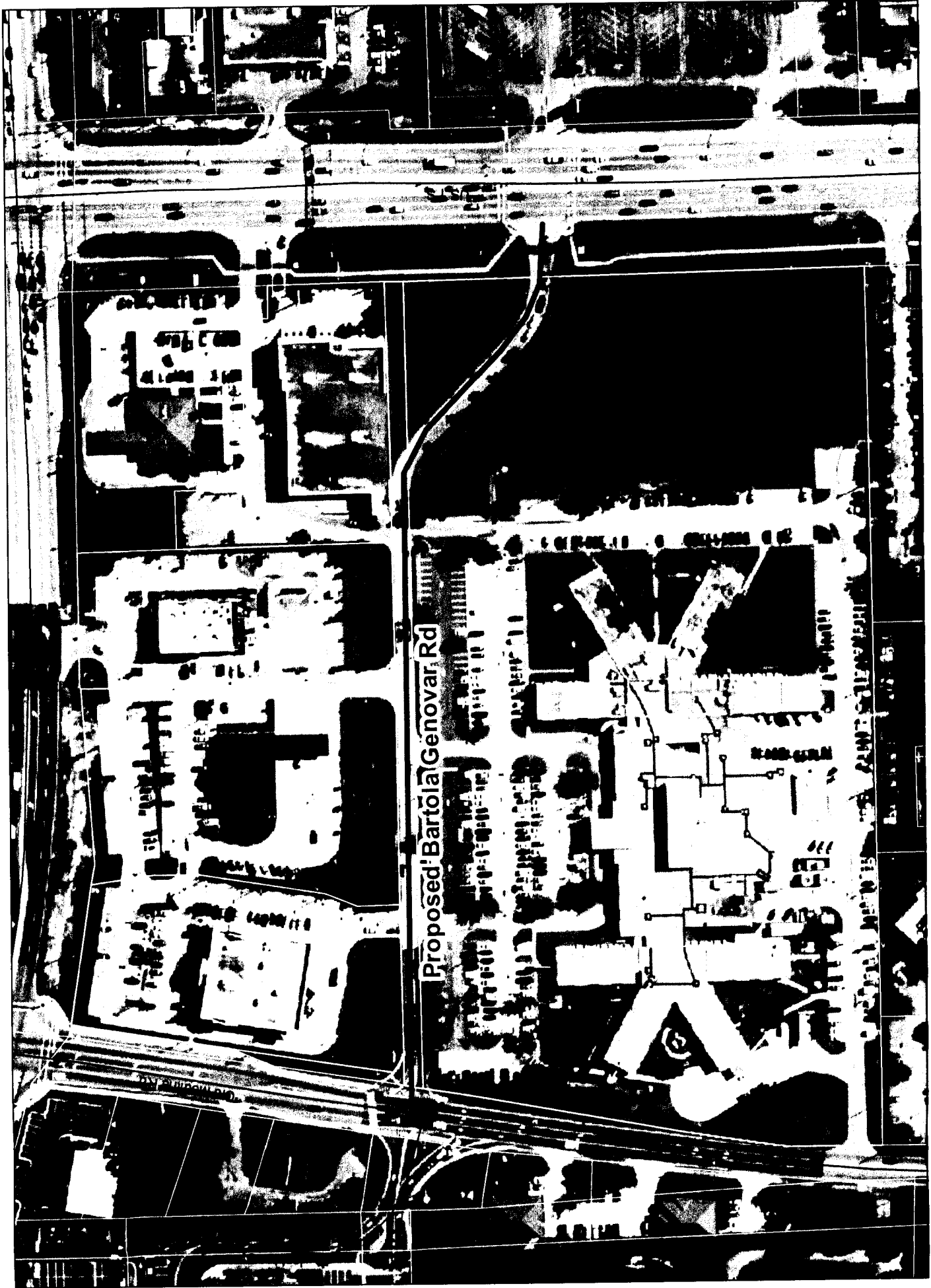
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
The Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, February 3, 2009, at 9:30 am in the County Administration Building, San Sebastian View, Augustine, Florida.

The purpose of the public hearing will be to consider and determine a uniform road to Bartola Genovar Road lying immediately north of the St. Johns County Health and Human Services Center located at 1955 U.S. 1 South between US Highway 1 South and Old Maultrie Road. Interested parties may appear at the public hearing and be heard with respect to the proposed road naming.

If a person decides to appeal any decision made by the Board of County Commissioners with respect to any matter considered at the public hearing, he/she will need a record of the proceedings, and for such purposes he/she may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
